

GOD'S HEALING COVENANT

Exodus 15:26

"If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. **For I am the LORD who heals you.**"

Exodus 23:25,26

²⁵"So you shall serve the LORD your God, and He will bless your bread and your water. And I will take sickness away from the midst of you. ²⁶No one shall suffer miscarriage or be barren in your land; **I will fulfill the number of your days.**

Psalms 103:1-5

¹Bless the LORD, O my soul; And all that is within me, *bless* His holy name! ²Bless the LORD, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits: ³Who forgives all your iniquities, **Who heals all your diseases,** ⁴Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with loving kindness and tender mercies, ⁵Who satisfies your desire with good things, *So that* your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Psalms 107:19-20

¹⁹Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses. ²⁰**He sent His word and healed them,** and delivered *them* from their destructions.

JESUS REVEALED GOD'S WILL

Acts 10:38

³⁸How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, **who went about doing good and healing all** who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Luke 4:18,19

¹⁸*"The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me ***to heal the brokenhearted,** To proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed;* ¹⁹*To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD."**

Matthew 8:16,17

¹⁶When evening had come, they brought to Jesus many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and **healed all who were sick,** ¹⁷that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: *"He Himself took our infirmities And bore our sicknesses."**

Matthew 9:35

³⁵Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing every sickness and every disease** ***among the people.**

Mark 1:40-42

⁴⁰Now a leper came to Him, imploring Him, kneeling down to Him and saying to Him, "If You are willing, You can make me clean." ⁴¹Then Jesus, moved with compassion, stretched out *His* hand and touched him, and said to him, **"I am willing; be cleansed."** ⁴²As soon as He had spoken, immediately the leprosy left him, and he was cleansed.

Matthew 14:34-36

³⁴When they had crossed over, they came ^oto the land of Gennesaret. ³⁵And when the men of that place recognized Him, they sent out into all that surrounding region, brought to Him all who were sick, ³⁶and begged Him that they might only touch the hem of His garment. **And as many as touched it were made perfectly well.**

Luke 6:19

¹⁹And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, **for power went out from Him and healed them all.**

Luke 13:10-13,16

¹⁰Now He was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath. ¹¹And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise *herself* up. ¹²But when Jesus saw her, **He called her to Him and said to her, “Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity.”** ¹³And He laid *His* hands on her, **and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.** ¹⁶**So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound—think of it—for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?”**

YOUR FAITH RECEIVES HEALING

Luke 7:2-3,6-10

²And a certain centurion’s servant, who was dear to him, was sick and ready to die. ³So when he heard about Jesus, he sent elders of the Jews to Him... ⁶Then Jesus went with them. And when He was already not far from the house, the centurion sent friends to Him, saying to Him, “Lord, do not trouble Yourself, for I am not worthy that You should enter under my roof. ⁷Therefore I did not even think myself worthy to come to You. **But say the word, and my servant will be healed.** ⁸For I also am a man placed under authority, having soldiers under me. And I say to one, ‘Go,’ and he goes; and to another, ‘Come,’ and he comes; and to my servant, ‘Do this,’ and he does *it*.” ⁹When Jesus heard these things, He marveled at him, and turned around and said to the crowd that followed Him, **“I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel!”** ¹⁰And those who were sent, returning to the house, found the servant well ^owho had been sick.

Luke 8:43-48

⁴³A woman, having a flow of blood for twelve years, who had spent all her livelihood on physicians and could not be healed by any, ⁴⁴came from behind and touched the border of His garment. immediately her flow of blood stopped. ⁴⁵And Jesus said, **“Who touched Me?”** When all denied it, Peter ^oand those with him said, “Master, the multitudes throng and press You, ^oand You say, ‘Who touched Me?’” ⁴⁶But Jesus said, **“Somebody touched Me, for I perceived power going out from Me.”** ⁴⁷When the woman saw that she was not hidden, she came and falling down before Him, she declared to Him in the presence of all the people the reason she had touched Him and how she was healed immediately. ⁴⁸**And He said to her, “Daughter, *be of good cheer; your faith has made you well. Go in peace.”**

Matthew 15:21-28

²¹Then Jesus went out from there and departed to the region of Tyre and Sidon. ²²And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, “Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed.” ²³But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, “Send her away, for she cries out after us.” ²⁴But He answered and said, **“I was not sent except**

to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.” ²⁵Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, “Lord, help me!” ²⁶But He answered and said, “**It is not good to take the children’s bread and throw it to the little dogs.**” ²⁷And she said, “Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters’ table.” ²⁸**Then Jesus answered and said to her, “O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire.”** And her daughter was healed from that very hour.

BELIEVERS CALLED TO HEAL

Luke 9:1,2

¹Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. ²**He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.**

John 14:12-14

¹²“**Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.**” ¹³And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. ¹⁴**If you *ask anything in My name, I will do it.**

Mark 16:15-18

¹⁵And He said to them, “**Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.**” ¹⁶**He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.** ¹⁷And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; ¹⁸they^o will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; **they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.**”

James 5:13-15

¹³Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing psalms. ¹⁴Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. ¹⁵**And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up.** And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

Acts 5:14-16

¹⁴And believers were increasingly added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, ¹⁵so that they brought the sick out into the streets and laid *them* on beds and couches, that at least the shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them. ¹⁶Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, and **they were all healed.**

Acts 8:5-8

⁵Then Philip went down to ^othe city of Samaria and preached Christ to them. ⁶And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did. ⁷For unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and **many who were paralyzed and lame were healed.** ⁸And there was great joy in that city.

Acts 9:11,12

¹¹So the Lord *said* to him, “**Arise and go to the street called Straight, and inquire at the house of Judas for one called Saul of Tarsus, for behold, he is praying.**” ¹²And in a vision

he has seen a man named **Ananias coming in and putting *his* hand on him, so that he might receive his sight.**"

JESUS PAID FOR YOUR HEALING

John 10:10

¹⁰The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. **I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly.**

Galatians 3:13,14

¹³**Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law**, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "*Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree*"*),

¹⁴that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

1 Peter 2:24

²⁴who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—**by whose stripes you were healed.**

Isaiah 53:4,5

⁴Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. ⁵But He *was* wounded for our transgressions, *He was* bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace *was* upon Him, **And by His stripes we are healed.**

READ & SAY GOD'S WORD CONTINUALLY

Proverbs 4:20-22

²⁰My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. ²¹Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; ²²**For they *are* life to those who find them, And health to all their flesh.**

Mark 11:22,23

²²Jesus said to them, "**Have faith in God.** ²³**For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.**

Hebrews 10:23

²³Let us hold fast the confession of *our* hope without wavering, for **He who promised is faithful.**

Hebrews 10:35,36

³⁵Therefore **do not cast away your confidence**, which has great reward. ³⁶For you have need of endurance, so that after you have done the will of God, you may receive the promise.

PRAISE GOD FOR YOUR HEALING

Romans 4:19-:21

¹⁹Not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a 100 years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb. ²⁰He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, **giving glory to God,** ²¹**and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.**
